

Final Exam Assessment – HIST 3310 Summer 2025 (ASU)

TASK: Explain how sports have been crucial to constructing identity in the Americas by analyzing how one specific form of identity changed over time (national identity, gender identity, racial identity, ethnic identity etc. - you choose)

Refer to the readings and assignments specific to your chosen topic as a starting point. Your objective is to synthesize the select readings and other materials related to assignments. In other words, make them speak to each other. Your main point (thesis) needs to be supported by these secondary sources, and a few primary sources.

Product submission >> In 200-250 words, write a (2) two-paragraph explanation of your topic, main argument (thesis), findings, and an overview of the digital tool. Include a URL hyperlink to your product.

Bonus points if your blog post explanation speaks to how your work fits within the larger academic literature on the subject.

1. Show how sports shaped identities across the Americas by choosing one form of identity to examine
2. Trace how identity changes and evolves over time
3. Explain your main argument through a digital tool product (StoryMap JS, Sutori, Genially, or a 5-minute digital storytelling film - DST)
